

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Community Development Block Grant)

RES. NO. 42-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did solicit the participation of the eleven political
2 districts of the Papago Reservation for priority needs of their
3 respective districts; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe considers that the Papago Nursing Home continues to
5 be a priority need, and

6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did receive two other proposals from Gu Vo and Sif
7 Oidak Districts for prospective projects as follows:



9 1. Gu Vo District Housing Rehabilitation Project
10 2. Sif Oidak District Egg Production Complex

11 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has determined its intent to apply for CDBG
12 Program funds for the purpose of the above projects; and

13 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and
14 authorizes the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Treasurer to consult with
15 and negotiate for CDBG funding and to execute any and all contracts
16 and legal documents and any amendments thereto which may be necessary
17 to implement the project.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
20 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V
23 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
25 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
26 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
27 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
28 the Papago Council.
