WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe considers that the Papago Nursing Home continues to be a priority need, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did receive two other proposals from Gu Vo and Sif
Oidak Districts for prospective projects as follows:

- 1. Gu Vo District Housing Rehabilitation Project
- 2. Sif Oidak District Egg Production Complex

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has determined its intent to apply for CDBG

Program funds for the purpose of the above projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and authorizes the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Treasurer to consult with and negotiate for CDBG funding and to execute any and all contracts and legal documents and any amendments thereto which may be necessary to implement the project.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the $\underline{13th}$ day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\underline{1640.0}$ for; $\underline{-0}$ against; $\underline{-0}$ not voting; and $\underline{03}$ absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
