

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Notification of Intent to apply for Small Reclamation Loan)

RES. NO. 429-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation entered into an Agreement with the United
2 States Department of Interior, dated October 11, 1983, to accomplish
3 the requirements of P.L. 97-293, Southern Arizona Water Rights Settle-
4 ment Act ("the Act"), and entered into a further contract with the
5 Bureau of Reclamation dated April 30, 1984, pursuant to P.L. 93-638
6 to provide the services and facilities necessary to accomplish the
7 requirements of the Act; and
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9 WHEREAS, It is the responsibility of the Tohono O'odham Nation under the terms
10 of the Act to 1) subjugate land for which distribution systems are to
11 be planned, designed, and constructed by the United States Secretary
12 of the Interior, and 2) operate, maintain, and replace those systems
13 in accordance with the Act; and
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15 WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District has subcontracted services to provide a
16 development plan report and an environmental assessment which are
17 near completion; and

18 WHEREAS, Federal funding will be necessary by 1988 to have construction of the
19 facilities, as outlined in the Act, complete by the 1992 delivery
20 date; and

21 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council and Schuk Toak District have approved, in
22 concept, Development Alternative Number 7B as presented by Franzoy.
23 Corey Engineers and Architects.
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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Schuk Toak District Council hereby
26 requests that the Tohono O'odham Nation file a Notice of Intent with
27 the United States Bureau of Reclamation on behalf of the Schuk Toak
28 District, and notify the appropriate State and Federal agencies of
29 the Nation's intent to make a loan application under the Small
30 Reclamation Projects Act of 1956 (P.L. 84-984).
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32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Schuk Toak District Council requests that the
Tohono O'odham Nation contract with Franzoy. Corey Engineers and

1 Architects to prepare the loan application and provide the necessary
2 services associated with the processing and approval of the applica-
3 tion.


4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the negotiated amount of the contract shall be
5 reviewed by the Legislative Council prior to being approved by the
6 Chairman of the Executive Branch.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization shall not be deemed an election
8 or a decision by this Council of the final alignment or location of
9 the water delivery and distribution system or of the farming facilit-
10 ies referred to in or contemplated by the Act.



12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
13 United States Bureau of Reclamation with the Notice of Intent.

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th
15 day of September, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1422.5 for; 159.5 against; 58.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) and (i) (2) of Article VI of the
18 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
