9 does hereby authorize expenditures from the District's accounts in
10 accordance therewith.

13 day of September, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
14 of 1385.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 255.0 absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Consti-
16 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
