

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Citizen Participation certification)

RES. NO. 43-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has submitted an application for a grant to fund
2 certain eligible Indian Community Development Block Grant Program
3 activities and in connection with such application resolve and made
4 certain assurances:

6 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

7 Prior to the submission of its application, the governing body of
8 the Papago Tribe has:


9 Provided Tribal citizens, through their Council representatives,
10 especially those living in areas where activities are proposed or
11 on going, with adequate information concerning the amount of funds
12 available for proposed community development and housing activities
13 the range of activities that may be assisted, and other important
14 program requirements, and solicited their views and participation.
15 Followed traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement through
16 District Council meetings and Tribal Council meetings, opportunity
17 to articulate needs, express preferences about proposed community
18 development and housing activities, assist in the selection of
19 district priorities, and otherwise participate in the development of
20 the application.

22 (No part of this paragraph shall be construed to restrict the re-
23 sponsibility and authority of the applicant for development of the
24 application and the execution of its Community Development Block
25 Grant Program. Accordingly, the citizen participation requirements
26 of this paragraph do not include concurrence by any person or group
27 involved in citizen participation in making final determinations
28 concerning the findings and contents of the application. The sole
29 responsibility and authority to make such final determinations rest
30 exclusively with the Tribal Council.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th
2 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
3 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2a and (h) of Article V of
5 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
6 fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
7 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
8 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
9 of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
10 Council.
