5 and


6 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee allocated funds from savings of the
7 Hiatic O'Odham Program Budget FY 86.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
9 it hereby adopts the budget amendment for the Law & Order Committee to
10 cover over-expenditures of the FY 86 Budget.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding appropriated for the budget amendment is
13 savings from the Hiatic O'Odham Program Budget FY 86.

15 day of September, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1322.0 for; -0- against; 63.0 not voting; and 255.0 absent, pursuant to the
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) (3) of Article VI of the Consti-
18 tution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secre- tary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
