

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Addressing Standing Committee recommendations and
abolishment of Committee)

RES. NO. 452-86

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on August 27, 1986 enacted Res-
2 olution No. 407-86 which accepts the first recommendation to enact a
3 moratorium on all commercial and large scale non-Indian residential
4 development subject to all lands of the Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council needs to address the other five (5) recom-
7 mendations listed in the "Statement of the Standing Committee of the
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation".

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council deal
10 with the other five recommendations of the Land Lease Committee at the
11 November Council session.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that once the recommendations are addressed the Standing
13 Committee will be abolished.

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15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15th
16 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 954.5 for; 569.0 against; 116.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a)(b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
19 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
