WHEREAS, Pisinemo District initiated the Santa Cruz Demonstration Farm to revitalize the agricultural economy of the Reservation and to provide fresh local food; and

WHEREAS, Pisinemo District has organized a public body known as the Pisinemo

Development Authority to own and manage new District business enter
prises to the District and to the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Administration for Native American (ANA), has announced the availability of financial assistance to promote self sufficiency through support of local, social and ecomomic development projects.

WHEREAS, The Pisinemo Development Authority has developed an Agriculture Economic Development proposal to promote self sufficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council supports the establishment by the Pisinemo Development Authority of the proposed Agricultural Services and also supports the Pisinemo Development Authority in identifying funds as are available from Federal agencies for agricultural development, on the condition that such funds are not funds from which Papago or Vaiva Vo Farms or other Tribal agricultural programs are normally funded, and that the Pisinemo Agriculture Economic Development Project proposal will not compete for funding with any current Tribal programs.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
