

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Delaying the adoption of Election Ordinance)

RES. NO. 464-86

1 WHEREAS, the Election Board did submit and review the amended Uniform Election
2 Ordinance with the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

3 WHEREAS, such amendments were necessary to comply with the new Constitution;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is concerned that the
6 Districts be given an opportunity to review the changes before the
7 Legislature takes final action.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Council shall delay
10 adopting the amended Uniform Election Ordinance until October 27,
11 1986.


12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 17th
13 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
14 1456.0 for; 63.0 against; 120.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
16 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January
17 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
18 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
19 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
