

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support of Gu Achi District Resolution No. 986-01)

RES. NO. 466-86

1 WHEREAS, Superintendent James A. Barber did submit to the Gu Achi District an
2 application for Right-of-way with supporting documents from the BIA,
3 Phoenix Area Office, Branch of Roads; and

4 WHEREAS, the application for construction, operation and maintenance of Route
5 29, Project P-29-2 is located within the Gu Achi District boundaries;

7 WHEREAS, at our regular district meeting held on June 11, 1986 the Council did
8 grant permission to the Roads Department Papago Indian Agency to
9 conduct a preliminary survey on upcoming project P-29-2; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Indian Agency Superintendent, James A. Barber, by cover
11 letter of August 6, 1986 is requesting the review and approval of
12 roads Right-of-way project from the Gu Achi District Council.


14 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
15 hereby affirm the approval of Roads Right-of-way Project P-29-2.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 20th
18 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1471.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 169.0 absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i) (1) of Article VI of the Constitu-
21 tion of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
22 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
24 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
