1 WHEREAS, the BIA Phoenix Area Office, Branch of Roads did submit application
2 for Roads Project PIR 15 (19) within the Gu Achi District Boundaries;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Project PIR 15 (19) application packet dated August 6, 1986 does
5 include a map, environmental assessment report, archeological survey,
6 etc.; and

8 WHEREAS, Superintendent, James A. Barber for the Papago Indian Agency, is re-
9 questing from the district council, the approval of Project by Reso-
10 lution; and


11 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council is aware of the road project and has re-
12 viewed the application at two (2) district meetings; and

13 WHEREAS, on May 2, 1984 the District Council did submit to the Tohono O'Odham
14 Nations administration a resolution for review pertaining to road
15 improvements.



17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Council does hereby
18 support the Roads Project PIR 15 (19).

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 20th
20 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1471.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 169.0 absent, pursuant to the
22 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i) (1) & (2) of Article VI of the
23 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation
24 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
26 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




