WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard evidence from the O'odham Education Committee and other sources of mismanagement, discrimination and unfair dealings in the management and operation of the San Simon School by Mr. Whitehorn, School Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council is seriously concerned about its effect upon the education and well being of Papago children and upon the ability of the Superintendent effectively to work with reservation school boards for their benefit; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard the recommendations of the Education Committee and concurs therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept the recommendations of the Education Committee and directs that it appoint a task force, which shall include a member of each reservation BIA school board, to document the evidence submitted to the Committee and this Council, and to submit the report and recommendations to this Council within 30 days.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Education Department is authorized and directed, at a planned meeting with Dr. Ross, to recommend that Mr. Whitehorn, by written reprimand and order, be reprimanded and instructed to develop a plan within 30 days, which will address the financial conditions of all reservation schools and which will assure continued school operations without adversely affecting existing programs and positions at the San Simon School or any other BIA reservation schools.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1471.0 for; -0- against; 169.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
