

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Opposing President's 1986 IHS Rescission request)

RES. NO. 48-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised that President Reagan is seeking
2 a rescission of 1986 appropriations for the Indian Health Services
3 ("I.H.S.") in the amount of \$24,262,000 for Health Services and
4 \$38,642,00 for facilities construction, which rescission, when com-
5 bined with the automatic sequestrations mandated by Gramm-Rudman
6 (the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit and Control Act of 1985)
7 in the amounts of \$10,429,00 for Health Services and \$467,000 for
8 facilities construction, would lead to a combined reduction for the
9 I.H.S. in the amount of \$73,800,000 below the amounts authorized by
10 Congress in the 1986 Continuing Resolution (P.L. 99-190); and

12 WHEREAS, The Council also has been advised that the President proposes to
13 further reduce the 1987 appropriations for the I.H.S. by \$61,125,000
14 for Health Services and to completely eliminate all funding for
15 facilities construction; and


17 WHEREAS, The combined rescission, sequestrations and reductions proposed by
18 the President over the two-year period will result in a 10 per cent
19 funding reduction for the I.H.S. rather than the maximum three per
20 cent reduction originally envisioned by Gramm-Rudman, and are tanta-
21 mount to the abandonment of the Government's 30-year mission to bring
22 Health standards among American Indian tribes to a level comparable
23 to that of the general population.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
26 urgently request that Congress refuse to give approval to the Presi-
27 dents 1986 rescission request and continue to honor its historic
28 mission to bring the Health standards among American Indian Tribes to
29 a level comparable to that of the general population by making sure
30 that 1987 appropriations for the Indian Health Service be set at
31 safe levels so that they will not be affected by executive rescission
32 or sequestration.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate officers of
2 this Council are hereby directed forthwith to communicate this
3 Council's concerns to the Arizona Congressional delegation and to the
4 proper committees of Congress.

6 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
7 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
8 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
9 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(d) of Article V of the
10 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
11 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
12 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
13 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
14 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
15 Council.
