

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Process be implemented for removal of Treasurer
and Comptroller)

RES. NO. 493-86

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council met on October 23, 1986 and the issue of non
2 compliances of Legislative Council resolutions and directives surfaced
3 regarding the Treasurer and Comptroller; and

4 WHEREAS, previous complaints were brought to the attention of the Legislative
5 Council against the two individuals with no action from the immediate
6 Supervisor.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the process be initiated for the removal of
8 the Treasurer and the Comptroller.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the matter be referred to the Rules Committee.

10 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23rd.
11 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
12 1277.5 for; 52.5 against; 310.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
13 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
14 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
15 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
