

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Violation of Resolution No. 446-86 and 548-85
by the Treasurer)

RES. NO. 496-86

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 446-86,
2 wherein the Council authorized a \$50,000 time certificate of deposit
3 for Mr. Kenneth Jose so that a line of credit at the First Interstate
4 Bank could be established; and
5

6 WHEREAS, the Treasurer instead has made arrangements to borrow \$50,000.00 in
7 the form of a loan to establish Mr. Jose's line of credit without the
8 Council's approval; and

9 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 548-85 authorizes the Treasurer to make available
10 Tribal funds to expedite and complete the construction of the grocery
11 store as soon as possible.


12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has been presented a resolution
13 requesting authorization to borrow \$250,000.00 for the Sells Shopping
14 Center so Tribal funds used to complete the Sells Shopping Center can
15 be paid off; and

17 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council views the actions of the Treasurer on the
18 above resolutions as a direct violation of their intent.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
20 hereby directs the Acting Chairman of the Legislative Council to im-
21 mediately send a letter to the Chairman of the Nation requesting that
22 he take immediate disciplinary action on the Treasurer. The action is
23 to be in the form of dismissal, resignation or suspension without pay
24 for violation of Resolution No. 446-86 and Resolution No. 548-85.

26 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 24th
27 day of October, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 1519.5 for; -0- against; 120.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
29 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
30 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
