

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Opposition to amend of 25 U.S.C. 1407, Affecting Per Capita Payments)

2 WHEREAS, the United States Senate has, by enactment of Section 772 of the Budget
3 Reconciliation Act of 1985, S. 1730, attempted to amend Section 7 of
4 the Act of October, 1973, 25 U.S.C. 1407, in order to apply a \$2,000
5 limit on uncounted income to Social Security Act programs, and for
6 purposes of all Federally assisted programs, to calculate the \$2,000
7 limit on the aggregate of all per capita payments received in a year by
8 all members of a family unit; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives has, by a companion bill,
11 H.R. 3128, refused to follow the Senate's lead and amend 25 U.S.C.
12 1407, and the Senate-House Conference Committee did on December 19,
13 1985 direct the General Accounting Office to conduct a study of the
14 effect of such amendment; and

15 WHEREAS, the effect of the amendment would peremptorily alter the Federal
16 treatment of per capita distributions of Tribal funds among Tribal
17 members, and the consequences thereof would fall most harshly on the
18 neediest of Tribal families as more fully appears in a letter dated
19 December 10, 1985, from the Honorable Morris K. Udall, Chairman of the
20 Committee on Interior Insular Affairs, to the Honorable Harold E. Ford,
21 Chairman of the Committee on Public Assistance and Unemployment
22 Compensation, a copy of which is attached hereto.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it thanks the
25 Honorable Morris K. Udall for taking the lead in opposing the amendment
26 of 25 U.S.C. 1407 proposed by S. 1703, and urgently requests the
27 Honorable Barry Goldwater and Dennis DeConcini and other members of
28 Congress to refuse to change the Federal treatment presently and
29 historically given per capita distributions of Tribal funds among
30 Tribal members.

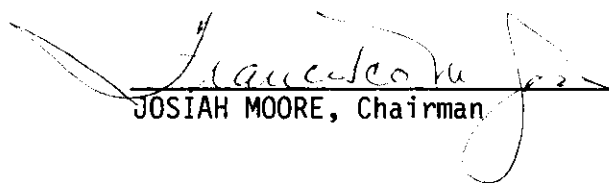

Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
