

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Supporting Funding for Alaska Natives)

RES. NO. 50-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised that President Reagan, by his 1987
2 appropriation requests for Indian programs, has proposed drastic re-
3 ductions in funding for Alaska natives in order to preserve the
4 funding levels for other Indian programs; and



6 WHEREAS, The Council is concerned that this action of the President, though on
7 the surface beneficial to Indian tribes, may cause significant damage
8 to Alaska native; and

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is also concerned that it may presage a policy of
10 termination of Alaska and Indian tribes, and of Federal services
11 benefiting them.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby urge
14 Congress to weigh the effect of the President's 1987 appropriation
15 requests upon Alaska natives before approving a final Federal budget.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
17 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the
20 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
21 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
