1 WHEREAS, On the 23rd of September, 1986, the Sells District Council did by
2 Resolution No. 54-86 approve the Sells District Revenue Sharing Budget
3 of \$13,401.00; and

5 WHEREAS, The foregoing Resolution approved by the Sells District Council does
6 hereby meet the requirements set forth in the Revenue Sharing Entitle-
7 ment No. 17 Guildlines; and

8 WHEREAS, The Sells District submit a budget to reflect the total amount allo-
9 cated by the Tohono O'odham Council.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
11 hereby approve the attached budget in the amount of \$13,401.00 of the
12 Sells District and authorize expenditures in accordance therewith.

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd
15 day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Consti-
18 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
