

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving funding, mapping, sampling and drilling  
of Chuipo and O'odham mining prospects)

RES. NO. 509-86

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolu-  
2 tion No. 264-86 authorize the search for funds in  
3 order to conduct and contract for geological mapping,  
4 geochemical sampling and drilling of the Chuipo (form-  
5 erly Greenback) and O'odham (formerly Papago) mining  
6 prospects within the Sif Oidak District; and  
7 WHEREAS, pursuant to the foregoing authorization, the Nation  
8 did obtain the equipment, support and/or services of  
9 Mr. Ken Cornelius, a professional consulting geolo-  
10 gist, the Division of Energy and Minerals of the  
11 Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Bureau of Mines and the  
12 Geological Survey in drilling five holes on the Chuipo  
13 mining prospect and one hole on the O'odham mining  
14 prospect, and in conducting geological, mapping and  
15 geochemical sampling thereof; and  
16 WHEREAS, this Council has been advised that further drilling,  
17 mapping and sampling of these prospects is necessary  
18 and justified and that the Division of Energy and  
19 Minerals may have funds available therefor.  
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman, Mining Direc-  
21 tor and other appropriate officers of the Nation are  
22 hereby authorized and directed to seek funds from the  
23 Bureau of Indian Affairs or any other federal agency  
24 for the purpose of further mapping, sampling and  
25 drilling the Chuipo and O'odham mining prospects.  
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the foregoing officers are author-  
27 ized and directed on behalf of the Nation to contract  
28 for such funds and to enter into contracts with Ken  
29 Cornelius, as consulting geologist, and other consul-  
30 tants and contractors for the purpose of further  
31 mapping, sampling and drilling of the Chuipo and  
32 O'odham mining prospects, giving to the foregoing

1 officers full authority and power to amend, change or rescind  
2 any such contracts.
