RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(To Override Veto of Resolution No. 458-86)

RES. NO. 511-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 458-86
2 appoint Ned Norris Jr., Malcolm Escalante, Donald Harvey, Hilda
3 Manuel, Joann Francisco and William Farrison as Judges of the Tohono
4 O'odham Judiciary; and

6 WHEREAS, Upon presentation of the Resolution to the Chairman of the Tohono
7 O'odham Nation he did disapprove thereof and returned it to the Council
8 with his objections in accordance with the provisions of Article VII,
9 Section 5 of the Constitution of the Nation; and

10 WHEREAS, The Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after consider-
11 ation again voted to pass Resolution No. 458-86.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby override the
13 Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 458-86.

15 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
16 day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and, by a
17 vote of 581.0 for; 921.0 against; 138.0 not voting; and 01 absent, failed to
18 override the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 458-86 pursuant to the powers
19 vested in the Council by Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution of the
20 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
21 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
22 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
23 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
