

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Soil and Water Conservation District)

RES. NO. 513-86

1 WHEREAS, It is the declared policy of the Tohono O'odham Council to provide for  
2 the conservation and restoration of natural lands, soil and water; and

3  
4 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation has requested, and is being provided,  
5 technical assistance from the United States Department of Agriculture  
6 through the Soil Conservation Service; and

7 WHEREAS, Technical assistance from the Soil Conservation Service must be pro-  
8 vided through a Conservation District; and

9 WHEREAS, The technical assistance now being provided by the Soil Conservation  
10 Service is controlled by and dependent on the priorities of three  
11 separate Conservation Districts; and

13 WHEREAS, None of the Conservation Districts involved has any voting representa-  
14 tion from the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding establishment of Conser-  
15 vation District priorities; and

16 WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to receive services  
17 directly from the Soil Conservation Service without the involvement of  
18 a third party; and

19 WHEREAS, The creation of an autonomous Soil and Water Conservation District  
20 established under authority of the Tohono O'odham Nation would allow  
21 the Soil Conservation Service to provide technical assistance directly  
22 to the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

24 WHEREAS, An autonomous Tohono O'odham Soil and Water Conservation District  
25 would have the authority to develop its own Long Range Plan for the  
26 conservation district which would establish priorities under which the  
27 Soil Conservation Service would operate on the Tohono O'odham Nation.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it shall  
29 establish an autonomous Soil and Water Conservation District of the  
30 Tohono O'odham Nation, created under authority of the Legislative  
31 Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th  
2 day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
3 of 1283.0 for; 236.5 against; 120.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
4 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i)(2) of Article VI of the Consti-  
5 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
6 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
7 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
8 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
