

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(San Lucy District Economic Development Capitalization Program)

1 WHEREAS, The San Lucy District through its development program (Vi-ikam Doag
2 Industries, Inc. and San Lucy Defense Support Industries, Inc.) has
3 since 1984 originated a strong economic development program including;

- 4
5 a) Manufacturing/cottage industry,
6 b) Industrial laundromat,
7 c) Travel industry (controlled tourism; and

8 WHEREAS, One BIA support grant (H50G14205879) is now in place for these
9 activities and another (H50G14206862) has been approved to assist in
10 financing a needed new building and equipment; and

11 WHEREAS, Even these grants will not fully adequate to fund all of the necessary
12 startup expenses for the above; and

13 WHEREAS, The present level of effort, if continued and given the supplemental
14 funding listed below, will result in the creation of approximately
15 fifteen (15.0) FTE and peicerate jobs for San Lucy District members
16 by February 1, 1987; and

17 WHEREAS, Two Work contracts are now in place or being finalized with:

- 18 1) McDonnell Douglas Helicopter Company
19 2) Martin Marietta Corporation
20 3) Indian Health Services.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation does hereby
22 approve the following proposal as the San Lucy FY 87 economic develop-
23 ment project to be funded by their share of \$100,000 from the IIM All
24 District Account.



The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1397.0 for; -0- against; 105.0 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2); (e) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
