## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Correcting Clerical Error in Constitution)

RES. NO. 524-86 WHEREAS, The qualified voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation did on January 18, 1986, adopt the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation which became effective on March 6, 1986 upon its approval by the Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations); and WHEREAS, Section 5 of article X of the Constitution provides that there shall be a primary election "for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation or of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the district council" if there are more than two (2) sets of candidates for such offices running in any general election; and WHEREAS, Section 7 of article X of the Constitution directs this Council to enact an election ordinance which shall prescribe rules and procedures necessary to the orderly conduct of all elections, including the holding of the primary elections for the offices described in section 5and referred to above, but by some clerical error refers to "primary elections for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham council and of the District Council," rather than to "primary

elections for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham <u>Nation</u> and the District Council" as provided in section 5 of article X; and

WHEREAS, This Council finds and determines that a clerical error was made in 23 section 7 of article X by referring to the Chairman and Vice Chairman 24 of the Tohono O'odham Council instead of the Tohono O'odham Nation and  $\mathbf{25}$  $\mathbf{26}$ that a substitution therein of the word "Council" for "Nation" is 27necessary in order to carry out the clear intention of the framers of 28 the Constitution and of the people adopting it, and in order (1) to be 29consistent with section 5 of article X, which provides for primary 30 elections for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono 31 O'odham <u>Nation</u>, (2) to be consistent with section 1 of article VII, 32

1 which provides that the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono 2 O'odham Nation shall be elected at large by a majority of votes cast 3 by all qualified votes and therefore requires primary elections if 4 there are more than two (2) sets of candidates running for such  $\mathbf{5}$ offices in any given general election, see setion 5 of article X, and 6 (3) to be consistent with section 4 of article V, which provides that 7 the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Council shall be 8 elected from within the Council's own membership and consequently and 9 10 necessarily without a primary election since the purpose of a primary 11 election is to reduce the number of candidates eligible for election 12 in the subsequent general election. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the foregoing findings 14 and determination, the "Nation" shall be substituted retroactively, 15 nunc pro tunc, instead of the word "Council" and that the pertinent 16 part of section 7 of article X of the Constitution of Tohono O'odham 17 18 Nation shall read and be construed, as follows: "The Tohono O'odham 19 Council shall enact an election ordinance which shall prescribe rules 20 . . . for the setting and holding of primary elections for the offices 21 of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation and of the 22 district council . . ." 23

24BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be referred to the Secretary of the25Interior or his authorized representative for his approval or

concurrence therein.

27 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1106.5 for; 137.5 against; 311.0 not voting; and 85.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(g) and (1) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act 31 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
