1	WHEREAS,	The members of the Papago Tribe on January 18, 1986, did adopt the

4		1,236 for; which is now currently pending approval by the Secretary
5		of Interior; and
6	WHEREAS,	The proposed Constitution when approved by the Secretary of Interior
7		would require a separation of powers between the Legislative, Execu-
8		tive, and Judicial branches of the Government; and
9	WHEREAS,	The Tribal Council would be required to develop and establish guide-
10		lines, policies & procedures, and/or regulations to ensure compliance
11		with the provisions of the New Constitution; and
12 13	WHEREAS,	The Council did by Resolution No. 76-85 and Resolution No. 355-86
14		establish and authorize the Policy & Procedures Committee to develop
15		necessary guidelines, policies & procedures, and/or regulations that
16		would govern the official business of the Council; and
17	WHEREAS,	In the process of developing such policies & procedures the Committee
18		identified certain tasks to be addressed by the Council in order to
19		comply with the New Constitution which is contained in the attached
20		outline estitled "legislative agenda"; and
21	WHEREAS,	The legislative agenda identifies the need for the appointment of a
22 23		Executive Committee of the Council to oversee the Constitutional
24		transition process; and
25	WHEREAS,	The Tribal Council finds that the Policy & Procedure Committee is the
26		proper body to undertake the responsibilities of the Executive Com-
27		mittee of the Council.
28	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does hereb
29		appoint the Policy & Procedures Committee as established and authori-
30		ized by Resolution No. 76-85 and extended by Resolution No. 355-85 to

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the $\underline{13th}$ day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\underline{1640.0}$ for; $\underline{-0}$ - against; $\underline{-0}$ - not voting; and $\underline{02}$ absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
