1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is concerned about the mining
2 report submitted by William Strickland, Attorney and Addison Smith,
3 Mining Director; and

4 WHEREAS, the report was on the current status regarding Noranda Mine; and

5 WHEREAS, Noranda Mine is seeking ways to reduce expenses by \$1,500,000.00; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is in support of seeking relief
7 to assist Noranda; and


8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is desirous of seeing Noranda
9 Mine stay in operation.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
12 the Tohono O'Odham Nation seek \$400,000.00 or more from the Bureau of
13 Indian Affairs, to defray cost in the research and development of In-
14 situ Leaching process.


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all efforts be made to keep Noranda Mine open.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17th
17 day of Novmeber, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1236.0 for; 85.0 against; 319.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
20 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
21 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
22 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
23 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
