NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation seek \$400,000.00 or more from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, to defray cost in the research and development of Insitu Leaching process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all efforts be made to keep Noranda Mine open.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the $\frac{17th}{day}$ of Novmeber, $\frac{1986}{day}$, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\frac{1236.0}{day}$ for; $\frac{85.0}{day}$ against; $\frac{319.0}{day}$ not voting; and $\frac{01}{day}$ absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
