

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing a temporary Election Board)


1 WHEREAS, This Council has enacted Ordinance No. 03-86, the Uniform Election
2 Ordinance, calling for the establishment and appointment by the Council
3 of an Election Board consisting of five Bilingual members of the
4 Nation for staggered terms of one to five years; and

6 WHEREAS, The Council has determined that it would be a mistake to appoint a new
7 Board so shortly before the forthcoming elections and that the ex-
8 isting Election Board should conduct and supervise such elections.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that the presently appointed
10 members of the Election Board are hereby appointed temporarily and
11 until June, 1987, as the Election Board, at which time the Council
12 shall make permanent appointments to the Board in accordance with
13 section 1 of article II of the ordinance.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th
16 day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 1513.0 for; 63.0 against; 64.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
21 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
22 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


