2 Allocation Methodology; and


3 WHEREAS, The Health staff and Health Board has also reviewed the Statement


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
10 hereby adopts the Position Paper authored by the Tohono O'odham Legis-  
11 tative Council Health Board and staff as the Tohono O'odham Nation's  
12 position on Resource Allocation Methodology (RAM).

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th  
15 day of November, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
16 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Consti-  
18 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
