

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Accepting Resignation of Chester L. Antone)

RES. NO. 53-86

1 WHEREAS, Chester L. Antone, elected representative from the Pisinemo District,
2 has rendered his resignation from the Papago Council; and



4 WHEREAS, The Papago Election Ordinance provides that, in the event a vacancy
5 should occur in the office of a District representative on the Papago
6 Council, his/her alternate shall succeed to the office for the unex-
7 pired term of such representative, and the District Council from which
8 the representative was elected shall select another alternate to
9 assume the office of the alternate.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept
11 the resignation of Chester L. Antone with regret and acknowledges
12 Sylvester Manuel as the representative from the Pisinemo District to
13 the Papago Council.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Pisinemo District
16 Council is invited to select another person for the position of
17 alternate to the Papago Council for the unexpired term of Sylvester
18 Manuel.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
20 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the
23 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
24 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
25 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
