

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Funding for the Extension of Vaiva Vo Farms)

RES. NO. 02-88

1 WHEREAS, on October 14, 1986, Public Law 99-469 was enacted into
2 law wherein it authorized the payment to the Tohono
3 O'odham Nation of six million dollars (\$6,000,000.00),
4 plus interest, provided the Nation executed the required
5 waiver and release and the required consent to the
6 rights-of-way and flood easement set forth in the Act;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, on October 13, 1987, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9 Council did pass a resolution wherein it approved and
10 authorized the Nation to execute an agreement between
11 the United States and the Tohono O'odham Nation to
12 provide for the implementation of the Act of October 14,
13 1987, (Tat Momolikot Dam Settlement Act) and on said
14 date the Chairman of the Nation did execute said
15 agreement and the consent for the required rights-of-way
16 and flood easement; and

17 WHEREAS, by a previous resolution, the Legislative Council did
18 authorize the sum of seven hundred and fifty thousand
19 dollars (\$750,000.00) be taken from the Six Million
20 Dollars (\$6,000,000.00), plus interest, when received
21 and paid to the Farming Authority as reimbursement for
22 the development of a well field and the power supply
23 which was made necessary by the U.S. Government's fail-
24 ure to deliver surface water from Tat Momolikot Dam; and


25 WHEREAS, the Farming Authority believes that it would be in the
26 best interest of the Sif Oidak District and the Nation
27 if the Vaiva Vo Farms are extended in accordance with
28 the development plan attached hereto and made a part
29 hereof and in order to do so, it will be necessary that
30 the Farming Authority acquire an additional Three
31 Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to be utilized in
32 accordance with the estimated cost set forth in said
development plan; and

1 WHEREAS, the Farming Authority believes that it would be in the
2 best interest of the Nation if part of the funding to be
3 received by the Nation as set forth in Public Law 99-469
4 be used for this purpose.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of
6 the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority does hereby request
7 that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council take the
8 necessary action to authorize the payment of Three
9 Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to the Farming Authority
10 from funding to be received by the Nation as set forth
11 in Public Law 99-469 to be utilized for the extension of
12 Vaiva Vo Farms in accordance with the development plan
13 attached hereto and made a part hereof.


14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham
15 Council on the 4th day of January, 1988, at a meeting at which a
16 quorum was present with a vote of 1,143.5 for; 252.5 against;
17 244.0 not voting; and 04 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in
18 the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by
20 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
21 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
22 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
