7 and


8 WHEREAS, data are, to the greatest extent feasible, independently

14 demographic data that are unpublished and not generally
15 available in order to meet the requirements of the
16 application process.

24 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
25 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


