(Hickiwan District Economic Development Withdrawal)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council received from the  
2 Hickiwan District Council, the Economic Development  
3 Resolution; and

4 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District would like to withdraw the said  
5 amount of \$100,000.00 and deposit it into a Valley  
6 National Bank.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham  
8 Legislative Council approve the withdrawal in the amount  
9 of \$100,000.00 for deposit into Valley National Bank,  
10 Ajo, Arizona.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any plans or proposals utilizing this  
12 allocation is subject to review and recommendation of  
13 the Budget & Finance and Commerce Committee.

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
15 Council on the 5th day of January, 1988, at a meeting at which a  
16 quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0-  
17 not voting; and 02 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the  
18 Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
19 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the  
20 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)  
21 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
22 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
