

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Tohono O'Odham Children's Home Program
P. L. 93-638 FY '89 Budget Contract)

RES. NO. 100-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation of Arizona is presently
2 operating the Tohono O'Odham Children's Home Program
3 under P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian
4 Affairs; and

5 WHEREAS, such Tribal Operations have been successful and
6 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations
9 requires that all proposals to recontract under P. L.
10 93-638 be submitted to the Tribal Council for approval
11 of at least 120 days prior to the contract termination;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does desire to
14 recontract for provision of these services during FY
15 1989; and

16 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
17 approved the Tohono O'Odham Children's Home Program
18 contract.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
21 Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'Odham
22 Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
23 the provision of services titled: Tohono O'Odham
24 Children's Home Program.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall
26 commence on October 01, 1988 and end September 30, 1989.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
29 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
30 being conducted and no executed contract has been
31 awarded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
