

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Tohono O'Odham Adult Care Group Home
Program P. L. 93-638 FY '89 Budget Contract)

RES. NO. 101-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently contracting for
2 non-medical adult group homes located on the reservation
3 under P. L. 93-638; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for
5 the operation of the on reservation Adult Group Home
6 Program; and

7 WHEREAS, such a community based program is beneficial to the
8 community and adult clients; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham nation has successfully operated
10 these group care facilities for two years; and

11 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations
12 requires that all contract proposals be submitted to the
13 Tohono O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days
14 prior; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for
16 continuation of the Adult Group Home Program; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the
18 Adult Care Group Home Program Contract.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
21 Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'Odham
22 Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
23 the provision of services titled: Adult Group Home
24 Program.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall
26 commence on October 01, 1988 and end September 30, 1989.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
29 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
30 being conducted and no executed contract has been
31 awarded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council


Tohono O'odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for the duration of the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd. day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
