

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Law Enforcement FY '89 Budget)

RES. NO. 102-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating Law  
2 Enforcement Services under FY '1988 P. L. 93-638  
3 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and  
5 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations require  
8 that all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be  
9 submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Council for approval at  
10 least 120 days prior to the contract termination; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for  
12 provision of these services during FY 1989; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the  
14 Law Enforcement Contract.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
16 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of  
17 Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'Odham  
18 Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for  
19 the provision of services titled: Law Enforcement

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will  
21 be from October 01, 1988 and end September 30, 1989  
22 unless extended by mutual agreement of both contracting  
23 parties.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not  
25 fund or operate programs for which contracts are  
26 requested which have not been negotiated and executed by  
27 the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the start of the  
28 funding year.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
30 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the  
31 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate  
32 and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for  
the duration of the contract, provided however, that any

amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
approval by this Council.


The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
on the 2nd. day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
present with a vote of 1,252.0 for; 201.5 against; 186.5 not  
voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
