

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Judicial Services)

RES. NO. 103-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Judicial Services under FY '88 P. L. 93-638 contract
3 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and
5 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;

6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations
7 requires that all proposals to recontract under P. L.
8 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Council for
9 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
10 termination; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for
12 provisions of these services during FY 1989; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the
14 Judicial Services Contract.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
17 Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'Odham
18 Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
19 the provision of services titled: Judicial Services.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will
21 commence on October 01, 1988 and end September 30, 1989.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
25 being conducted and no executed contract has been
26 awarded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
28 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
29 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate
30 and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for
31 the duration of the contract, provided however, that any
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
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
this contract shall be submitted for further prior
approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 2nd. day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 1,465.0 for; -0- against; 175.0 not
voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
