

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Reaffirming the Legislative Rules)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 105-88

1 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee reviewed the Legislative Committee
2 membership with the Tohono O'Odham Council on May 2,
3 1988; and

4 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee informed the Council that the
5 Committee membership is inconsistent with the
6 Legislative Rules adopted by the Council; and

7 WHEREAS, one reason cited is the Council waiving of Article XII,
8 Section 3.K (Special Requirements/Eligibility of
9 Candidates) by Resolution No. 203-87 to allow
10 Legislative Members to sit on three or more Committees;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council can either reaffirm its
13 Legislative Rules and take corrective action on those
14 Council members who are on less than or more than three
15 committees, or amend the Legislative Rules.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council to
17 reaffirm and abide by the Legislative Rules adopted by
18 Resolution No. 172-87 on May 1, 1987.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council abide by the Legislative Rules which states "A
21 Legislative Representative may serve on three (3) but no
22 more than three (3) Legislative Committees.

23 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
24 Council on the 2nd day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a
25 quorum was present with a vote of 1,390.0 for; 63.0 against;
26 187.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
27 in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the
28 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
30 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
31 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
32 Stat. 984).
