

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Indian Housing Improvement Program Act)

RES. NO. 10-88

1 WHEREAS, Senator Daniel F. Inouye, Chairman of the Senate Select
2 Committee on Indian Affairs, has circulated for comment
3 a bill entitled, Indian Housing Improvement Program Act,
4 which will codify current regulations of the Secretary
5 of the Interior contained in 25 C.F.R. Part 256 and
6 authorized by the Snyder Act; and

7 WHEREAS, this Council believes that the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
8 its members and Indians generally will be best served if
9 the Housing Improvement Program, presently administered
10 by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, pursuant to
11 departmental regulations, be administered pursuant to
12 specific laws and Congressional direction.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it
14 does hereby approve and support enactment into law of
15 the Indian Housing Improvement Program Act, and does
16 hereby authorize and direct the Chairman and other
17 appropriate officers of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to so
18 advise Senators Inouye, DeConcini and McCain, and to do
19 whatever is necessary or beneficial to achieve the
20 purposes of this resolution.

21 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham
22 Council on the 5th day of January, 1988, at a meeting at which a
23 quorum was present with a vote of 1523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0
24 not voting; and 01 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the
25 Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
26 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
27 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
28 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
29 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

submittal.


