

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Opposition to Indian Gaming Bill)

RES. NO. 114-88

1 WHEREAS, there is now pending before the U.S. Congress a Tribal
2 Gaming Bill wherein it provides for State jurisdiction
3 over gaming on Indian reservations; and

4 WHEREAS, if this pending Gaming Bill is enacted into law, it
5 would return Indian Reservation to the termination era
6 and it would be better for our people to have no bill
7 enacted in this session of Congress to have this state
8 jurisdiction bill; and

9 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation
10 that the Nation immediately notify the Congressional
11 Delegation and the National Congress of American
12 Indians of its opposition to the State jurisdiction
13 provision now existing in the Indian Gaming Bill pending
14 before this session of Congress.

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Legislative Council is
16 totally opposed to the provision providing for State
17 jurisdiction existing in the Indian Gaming Bill now
18 pending before the United States Congress.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Vice President for
20 the National Congress of American Indians, Harriet Toro,
21 is hereby directed to notify the National Congress of
22 American Indians of the Nation's opposition to the State
23 jurisdiction provision and further directs that the
24 Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation likewise
25 immediately notify the Congressional Delegation of the
26 Nation's opposition.

28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
29 on the 5th day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was
30 present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
31 and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
32 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
