RES. NO. 114-88

WHEREAS, there is now pending before the U.S. Congress a Tribal

Gaming Bill wherein it provides for State jurisdiction

over gaming on Indian reservations; and

WHEREAS if this pending Caming Bill is exacted into law its

whereas, if this pending Gaming Bill is enacted into law, it would return Indian Reservation to the termination era and it would be better for our people to have no bill enacted in this session of Congress to have this state jurisdiction bill; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation that the Nation immediately notify the Congressional Delegation and the National Congress of American Indians of its opposition to the State jurisdiction provision now existing in the Indian Gaming Bill pending before this session of Congress.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Legislative Council is totally opposed to the provision providing for State jurisdiction existing in the Indian Gaming Bill now pending before the United States Congress.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Vice President for the National Congress of American Indians, Harriet Toro, is hereby directed to notify the National Congress of American Indians of the Nation's opposition to the State jurisdiction provision and further directs that the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation likewise immediately notify the Congressional Delegation of the Nation's opposition.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th. day of May, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
