

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Rejection of membership application of  
Nubia Pazos)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 117-88

1 WHEREAS, an application for enrollment as a member of the Tohono  
2 O'Odham Nation has been filed by or on behalf of:

3 Nubia Pasoz

4 filed on the 1st. day of January, 1986; and

5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed the application  
6 and has recommended that the application be denied  
7 because the applicant failed to establish the following  
8 membership requirement(s): TOHONO O'ODHAM CONSTITUTION,  
9 ARTICLE II, MEMBERSHIP - SECTION (1A) & (1B); and

10 WHEREAS, the application has come on for hearing before this  
11 Council; and

12 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its  
13 recommendation to reject the application and of this  
14 hearing, as required by Section 2, Article VI of the  
15 Enrollment Ordinance, upon the person(s) who filed the  
16 application(s) and such person(s) was present at this  
17 hearing; and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed all of the  
19 evidence presented and from such evidence raised  
20 questions to the Enrollment Committee who were unable to  
21 respond or provide sufficient answers to their questions  
22 to support their recommendation.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that  
24 it does hereby determine that the application(s) of:  
25 Nubia Pazos is hereby tabled and referred back to the  
26 Enrollment Committee to obtain more information.

28 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
29 Council on the 6th. day of May, 1988, at a meeting at which a  
30 quorum was present with a vote of 1,030.0 for; 52.5 against;  
31 440.5 not voting; and 04 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in  
32 the Council by Article II and Section 1 (h) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
