

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recommending codification of separate Indian Housing Program)

RES. NO. 11-88

1 WHEREAS, the National American Indian Housing Council has, by
2 Resolution No. 87-8, recommended the codification of the
3 Indian Housing Program under a separate title within the
4 Department of Housing and Urban Development with certain
5 other changes in current law; and

6 WHEREAS, the Housing Committee of the Legislative Council,
7 finding that the housing needs of Indian people are
8 significantly different from the housing needs of the
9 general public, has supported the recommendation of the
10 National American Indian Housing Council; and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council concurs with the findings and
12 decision of the Housing Committee.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
14 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the
15 recommendation of the National American Indian Housing
16 Council as contained in Resolution No. 87-8, and directs
17 the Chairman and other appropriate officers and agents
18 of the Nation to advise the appropriate members and
19 committees of Congress of this decision and to do
20 everything necessary or appropriate to implement the
21 purposes of this resolution.

22 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
23 Council on the 5th day of January, 1988, at a meeting at which a
24 quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0-
25 not voting; and 01 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the
26 Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
28 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
29 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
30 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
