1 WHEREAS, an application for enrollment as members of the Tohono  
2 O'Odham Nation has been filed by or on behalf of:

3 John H. Mixon

4 Geneva L. Mixon ; and

5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed the applications  
6 and has recommended that the applications be denied  
7 because the applicants failed to establish the following  
8 membership requirement(s): TOHONO O'ODHAM CONSTITUTION,  
9 ARTICLE II, MEMBERSHIP - SECTION (1A) & (1B); and

10 WHEREAS, the applications has come on for hearing before this  
11 Council; and

12 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its  
13 recommendation to reject the application and of this  
14 hearing, as required by Section 2, Article VI of the  
15 Enrollment Ordinance, upon the person(s) who filed the  
16 application(s) and such person(s) were not present at  
17 this hearing; and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed all of the  
19 evidence presented and from such evidence finds that the  
20 applicant's background needs more research.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that  
22 it does hereby determine that the application(s) of:

24 Geneva L. Mixon

25 for enrollment as members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
26 is hereby tabled and referred back to the Enrollment  
27 Committee for more research.

28 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
29 Council on the 6th. day of May, 1988, at a meeting at which a  
30 quorum was present with a vote of 1,140.5 for; -0- against; 382.5  
31 not voting; and 07 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the  
32 Council by Article II and Section 1 (h) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
