

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Legal Opinion on Jose Antone)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 120-88

1 WHEREAS, an application for enrollment as a member of the Tohono
2 O'Odham Nation has been filed by or on behalf of:

3 Jose Antone

4 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed the application
5 and has recommended that the application be denied
6 because the applicant failed to establish the following
7 membership requirement(s): TOHONO O'ODHAM CONSTITUTION,
8 ARTICLE II, MEMBERSHIP - SECTION (1A) & (1B); and

9 WHEREAS, the application has come on for hearing before this
10 Council; and

11 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its
12 recommendation to reject the application and of this
13 hearing, as required by Section 2, Article VI of the
14 Enrollment Ordinance, upon the person(s) who filed the
15 application(s) and such person(s) was not present at
16 this hearing; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed all of the
18 evidence presented and from such evidence finds that the
19 applicant(s) name appeared on the official census roll
20 even though he was deceased prior to 1937; and

21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council questioned why
22 the name of Jose Antone should be removed from the
23 official census roll since the Council have made
24 additions to the roll.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that
26 it does hereby determine that the application(s) of:

27 Jose Antone

28 to reject for enrollment as a member of the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation is hereby not accepted but recommends
30 that a legal opinion be given.

32 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
Council on the 6th. day of May, 1988, at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1,024.5 for; -0- against; 498.5
not voting; and 07 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the

1 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
2 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
3 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
4 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
5 Stat. 984).
