12	provisions of these services during FY 1989; and
13	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the
14	FY 1989 Johnson O'Malley contract.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16	Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of
17	Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'Odham
18	Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
19	the provision of services titled: Johnson O'Malley.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to
21	change once a decision is made on the Cost of Living
22	Allowance (COLA) rate.
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will
24	commence on October 01, 1988 through September 30, 1989.

26	that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
