

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Agreement with Tribal Private Industry Council
for operation of JTPA Program)

RES. NO. 127-88

1 WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act, 25 U.S.C. § 1501 et
2 seq., ("JTPA") authorizes the expenditures of federal
3 funds for job training programs in Service Delivery
4 areas designated by the Governor of the State in
5 accordance with a Job Training Plan for each area which
6 has been prepared in accordance with procedures adopted
7 by each designated Private Industry Council; and

8 WHEREAS, nineteen (19) Indian Reservations, including the Tohono
9 O'Odham Nation, have been designated as a Tribal Service
10 Delivery Area for purposes of administering JTPA funds,
11 and the local Chief Elected Officials of each
12 Reservation have appointed a member to the Tribal
13 Private Industry Council to provide guidance and
14 oversight with respect to the Tribal Job Training Plans
15 serving the area; and

16 WHEREAS, the JTPA requires the Tribal Private Industry Council
17 and the Local Chief Elected Officials of each
18 Reservation to act in partnership to define the scope of
19 their authorities and responsibilities by means of an
20 Agreement; and

21 WHEREAS, the current agreement with the Tribal Private Industry
22 Council has expired and it is necessary to enter into a
23 new Agreement between the Tribal Private Industry
24 Council and the nineteen (19) Chief Elected Officials
25 representing the Reservations constituting the Tribal
26 Service Delivery Area; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the best
28 interest of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to enter into a
29 new Agreement with the Tribal Private Industry Council.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby
31 approve the form of the attached Agreement with the
32 Tribal Private Industry Council, and does hereby
authorize and direct the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham

1 Nation to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the
2 Nation substantially in the form submitted to this
3 Council.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
5 to request the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to
6 look into the possibility of the Tohono O'odham Nation
7 in receiving its own independent JTPA funding.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
10 on the 6th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
11 was present with a vote of 1,534.5 for; -0- against; 105.5
12 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
13 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
14 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
15 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
17 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
18 984).
