

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(JTPA Inter-Governmental Agreement Title II-A)

RES. NO. 128-88

1           WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in  
2           1982 replacing the Comprehensive Employment Training Act  
3           (CETA); and

4           WHEREAS, funding is made available to state and tribal  
5           governments to establish programs for improving the  
6           employment prospects of eligible persons through the  
7           designation of service delivery area; and

8           WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is entitled to JTPA funds to  
9           develop a network of employment training programs  
10          throughout the State; and

11          WHEREAS, the Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated  
12          as service delivery areas and are eligible to receive  
13          State JTPA funds; and

14          WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation JTPA Program may apply for  
15          State JTPA funds pursuant to Inter-Governmental  
16          Agreement with the State of Arizona.

17          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
18          Council that it hereby approves the contract with the  
19          State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security for  
20          the delivery of JTPA Services on the Tohono O'Odham  
21          Reservation.

22          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
23          that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
24          the program in the interim while negotiations are still  
25          being conducted and no executed contract has been  
26          awarded by the Department of Economic Security.

27          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
28          that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the  
29          Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate  
30          and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for  
31          the duration of the contract, provided however, that any  
32

amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
