

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Bilingual Educational Budget Amendment)

RES. NO. 133-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has been awarded a grant to
2 operate a Bilingual Educational Program; and

3 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
4 of the grant shall be submitted for review and approval
5 by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

6 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval
7 by the Bilingual Educational Program.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
9 Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to
10 the Bilingual Educational Program.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the
12 Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby
13 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant and any
14 amendments thereto for the duration of the grant,
15 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
16 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be
17 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 6th. day of June , 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
20 was present with a vote of 1,539.0 for; -0- against; 101.0
21 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
22 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
23 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
24 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
27 984).
