

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for Approval of Plan for Renovating Building No. 50)

RES. NO. 14-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was offered and accepted
2 Building No. 50, also known as the "Employees' Club
3 Building," from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, by Council
4 Resolution No. 44-71; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation accepted the aforementioned
6 building in accordance with the revisionary clause and
7 all other provisions of Public Law 991, an Act of
8 Congress, approved August 6, 1956; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was unable to recondition and
10 repair the aforementioned building due to lack of
11 sufficient funds; and

12 WHEREAS, due to the deteriorating condition of the aforementioned
13 building, the lack of repair and non-use, the Bureau of
14 Indian Affairs rescinded the transfer of the building;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has scheduled demolition of
17 aforementioned building; and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Human Service Department expressed a
19 need for additional office space and Building No. 50
20 would provide such needed space; and

21 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs agreed to suspend
22 demolition of Building No. 50 temporarily to allow the
23 Tohono O'odham Nation to present a plan for renovation
24 and repair of the aforementioned building for office
25 space; and

26 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Human Service Department does have
27 sufficient funds, "carry over monies," to fund the
28 renovation of Building No. 50 expediently; and

29 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has considered this offer by
30 the Papago Agency Superintendent and has determined that
31 this building can be put to good use for the Human
32 Service Program.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation requests that the
2 Bureau transfer title to the aforementioned building to
3 the Tohono O'odham Nation.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation accepts
5 this building subject to the processing and approval of
6 the P. L. 93-638 Social Service Contract carry over
7 funds for Fiscal Year 1986.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs review
9 and approve the attached plan for renovation of Building
10 No. 50.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham
12 Council on the 7th day of January, 1988, at a meeting at which a
13 quorum was present with a vote of 1,455.5 for; -0- against; 184.5
14 not voting; and 01 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the
15 Council by Section 1 (d)(3) & (i)(5) of Article VI of the
16 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
17 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
18 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
19 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
