

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending PTUA Plan of Operation -  
Cellular Radio Services)

RES. NO. 149-88

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Utility Authority ("PTUA") was  
2 established to provide utility services, including  
3 telephone service, to all areas of the Tohono O'odham  
4 Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission has announced that  
6 applications will be received between July 27 and July  
7 29, 1988, for a cellular radio license to serve Rural  
8 Service Area ("RSA") #322 (Arizona #5), which includes  
9 both Pinal and Gila counties and therefore the northern  
10 portion of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

11 WHEREAS, PTUA, as a telephone service company serving a portion  
12 of RSA, is eligible to file an application for a  
13 cellular radio license for the RSA, provided it is  
14 legally authorized to serve the RSA; and

15 WHEREAS, the Management Board of the PTUA has determined that it  
16 would be of benefit to PTUA and the Tohono O'odham  
17 Nation for PTUA to apply for and obtain a cellular radio  
18 license to serve the RSA, and has requested that the  
19 Legislative Council amend PTUA's Plan of Operation in  
20 order to authorize PTUA to provide cellular radio  
21 services both within and beyond the boundaries of the  
22 Tohono O'odham Nation; and

23 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council believes that it will be of  
24 benefit to PTUA and the Tohono O'odham Nation that PTUA  
25 be authorized to provide cellular radio services both  
26 within and beyond the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham  
27 Nation.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Plan of Operation of the  
29 Papago Tribal Utility Authority be, and it is hereby  
30 amended by adding a new paragraph 4 to subsection 4(A)  
31  
32

1 and by renumbering paragraphs 4 and 5 of subsection 4(A)  
2 as paragraphs 5 and 6, which new paragraph 4 shall read  
3 as follows:

4 To initiate, acquire, operate, maintain, promote  
5 and provide, alone or in cooperation with others,  
6 cellular radio services and facilities both within  
7 and beyond the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham  
8 Nation.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
10 on the 10th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum  
11 was present with a vote of 1,322.0 for; 201.0 against; 117.0  
12 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
13 Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
14 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
15 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
17 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
18 984).
